

**CONFIRMATION OF THE RECEIPT OF INFORMATION AND  
DECLARATION OF RELEASE FROM LIABILITY**

In the following, each child individually and all children collectively will be designated as “**child**”.

In the following, the parents or teachers and supervisors and the child will be designated collectively as “**visitors**”.

**PRELIMINARY REMARK**

(A) The visitors (or the child only or the children together with their teachers and supervisors) intend to take part in a tour of the site of Airbus Operations GmbH (hereinafter referred to as “**Airbus**”) in Hamburg-Finkenwerder (Kreetslag 10, 21129 Hamburg).

(B) The Airbus site is not generally accessible to the public. This means that all the facilities and installations are designed according to the provisions of the law on workplaces applicable to production areas. Since the law on workplaces assumes that no persons under the age of 14 are present in such areas, the facilities and installations on the site, in particular the railings, do not offer the protection that would be prescribed for areas accessible to the public.

(C) Airbus has expressly drawn visitors’ attention to the specific dangers resulting from this. In particular the visitors have been informed that the sides of many of the areas to be visited are only fitted with ordinary railings conforming to industrial standards; the hand and knee rails of such barriers do not offer children adequate protection against falling onto the floors below.

(D) Against this background, visitors hereby give Airbus the following Confirmation of the Receipt of Information and Declaration of Release from Liability for their visit to the plant:

**1. VISITORS' OBLIGATIONS**

1.1 The parents affirm that they have understood the safety precautions given by Airbus, especially in the preliminary remark, and that they are aware of the specific dangers involved in a tour of the plant.

1.2 The parents undertake to explain the safety precautions to their child in a way the child can understand, in particular to point out the danger of falling in areas where there are railings as barriers. They will tell the child not to enter areas fitted with railings without them (or the teachers or other persons responsible for accompanying them) and to cross areas with railings carefully and only on the side of the parents (or the teachers or other persons responsible for accompanying them) away from such railings.

1.3 The parents (or the teachers or other persons responsible for accompanying the child) undertake to observe these safety precautions themselves and to ensure that the child observes them likewise.

**2. FAILURE TO OBSERVE THE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

The visitors (or only the child or children with teachers and supervisors) are aware that Airbus must exclude them from continuing their visit to the company site if they fail to comply with the obligations entered in accordance with Point 1.

**3. RELEASE FROM LIABILITY**

The visitors (or only the child or children with teachers and supervisors) declare that they will enter the Airbus site at their own risk. The visitors (or only the child or children with teachers and supervisors) are aware that Airbus and its vicarious agents accept no liability for any damage or injury suffered by the visitors (or only the child or children with teachers and supervisors) during the tour of the plant, for whatever legal reason, except in the case of intent or gross negligence or culpable injury to the life, body or health of a visitor.

**4. PARENTS' LIABILITY**

Parents are liable for any damage caused by the child during the visit to the plant, irrespective of whether the child is old enough to be legally capable of tortious liability, whether the child is at fault or whether they have neglected their duty of supervision.
